Taking Care of Femoral (Cervical) Venous Catheter 股(頸)靜脈導管應注意事項(英文版)

- 1. When femoral venous catheter is placed in the body, take a sponge bath to avoid the insertion site getting wet. If it is wet, notify the nurse for a medical dressing change.
- 2. When a femoral venous catheter is placed in the body, the patient should avoid being in a sitting position for long periods, or getting out of bed to walk around.



- 3. When a femoral venous catheter is placed in the body, take a sponge bath only on the area above the chest, to avoid water on the insertion area. If the insertion area gets wet, notify the nurse for a medicine dressing change.
- 4. Keep the insertion site and catheter area clean. Do not scratch the area.
- 5. When observing redness, swelling, fever, pain, or bleeding, notify the medical professionals.

- 6. Dry any perspiration (sweat) to avoid contamination of the insertion site.
- 7. Notify the medical professionals when you feel the catheter has been

dislocated or if the suture has fallen off.

- 8. Do not remove the gauze or dressing. Notify the medical professionals when they come off.Do not remove the gauze or dressing.
- 9.Wear button-down shirts to avoid bending your neck which may pull and drag off the catheter.

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
