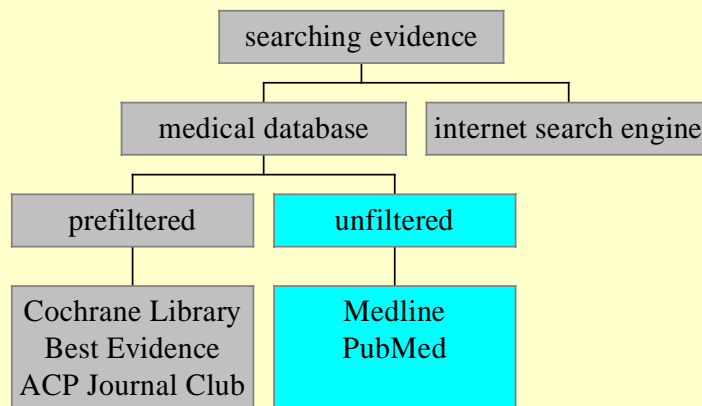
"pre-filtered" EBM resource

- To answer focused clinical questions, the most efficient approach is to begin with a "pre-filtered" evidence-based medicine resource such as
 - Best Evidence,
 - the Cochrane Library, or
 - Clinical Evidence

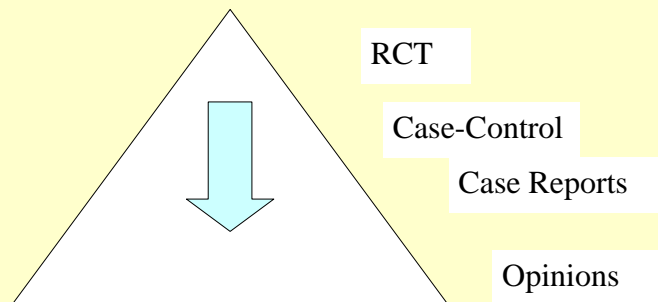

Searching

- **Key Words :**
- **搜尋策略 top down**



Can hyperbaric oxygenation accelerates the healing rate of nonischemic chronic diabetic foot ulcers?

PECOT

- P: nonischemic chronic diabetic foot ulcers
- E: Hyperbaric oxygenation accelerates
- C: wound care
- O: the healing rate
- T: one month

Summary points

- Not all medical articles are indexed on Medline, and many that are have been **misclassified**
- Searching by **textword** can supplement a search by MeSH headings
- To increase the sensitivity of a search, use the **"explode"** command and avoid using subheadings
- **Scan titles on screen** rather than relying on the software to find the most valid or relevant ones

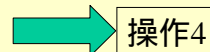

Strategies

Problem 1: You are trying to find a known paper 眾裡尋它

- Solution: Search the database by field suffix (title, author, journal, institution, etc) or by textwords.
- Useful search field suffixes (Ovid)

Strategies

Problem 2: You want to answer a specific question
直指核心

- *Solution: Construct a focused (specific) search by combining two or more broad (sensitive) searches*
- anorexia nervosa/ and osteoporosis/ and contraceptives, oral/

Strategies

Problem 3: You want to get general information quickly about a well defined topic
綜覽主題

- Solution: Use subheadings and/or the "limit set" options.
- limit 5 to human

Strategies

Problem 4: Your search gives irrelevant articles
去蕪存菁

- Solution: Refine your search as you go along in the light of interim results.
- i. INCREASING PRECISION 增加精確度
(WHERE THERE ARE TOO MANY HITS)
- ii. Boolean AND
- iii. Boolean NOT
- iv. Quality filters
- v. Limits
- vi. (surrogate not mother\$.tw)

Strategies

Problem 5: The search gives no articles, or too few (I)
絕處逢生

- Solution:
 - Firstly, don't overuse subheadings or the "limit set" options.
 - Secondly, search under textwords as well as MeSH terms.
 - Thirdly, learn about the "explode" command, and use it routinely

Problem 5: The search gives no articles, or too few (I)
絕處逢生

- i. INCREASING SENSITIVITY
(WHERE THERE ARE TOO FEW HITS)
- ii. Subject Headings/Trees
- iii. Scope notes (i)
- iv. Explode eg. exp asthma/
- v. Textword Searching

Strategies

Problem 5: The search gives no articles, or too few (I) 絕處逢生

- vi. Truncation and Wildcards * eg. Diabet\$
- vii. Adjacency eg. Adj diabetes
- viii. Boolean 'OR'
- ix. PubMed Related Articles, Link out
 - Each citation in PubMed has a link that will retrieve a pre-calculated set of PubMed citations that are closely related to the selected article.
 - Click on Related Articles to the right of each citation to display the related set of articles. PubMed creates this set by comparing words from the title, abstract, and MeSH terms using a powerful word weighted [algorithm](#).
 - Citations are displayed in rank order from most to least relevant, with the "linked from" citation displayed first.

Strategies

Problem 6: You don't know where to start searching 無從下手

- Solution: Use the "permuted index" option.
- 1 ptx stress
- **PTX Display**
 - When using the PTX tool, enter ONE WORD to search. The resulting PTX Tool Page displays all of the terms in the Tree or Thesaurus containing the word you entered.
 - This helps you find similar terms.
 - In the example below, the word "blood" was entered; note that all the displayed terms contain the word "blood".

Strategies

Problem 7: Limiting a set loses important articles but does not exclude those of low methodological quality

- *Solution: Apply an EBQF (evidence based quality filter).*
- PubMed filter

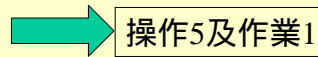

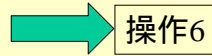

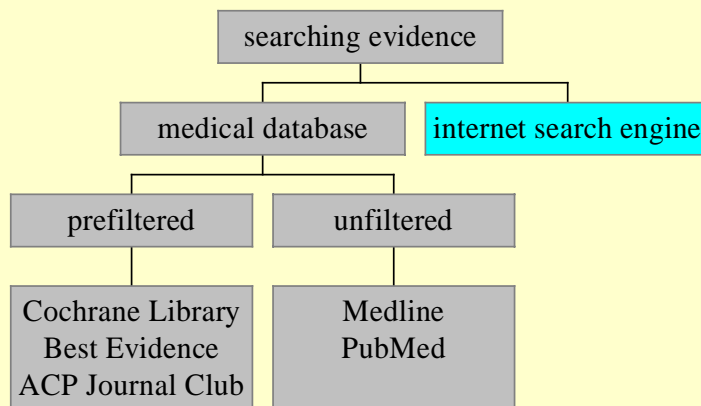

5. Meta Search

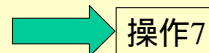
- MD consult
- TRIP database (*free*)
- SUM search (*free*)
- Dogpile (*General*)
- Mamma (*General*)

Meta Search Tools...

- Advantages:
 - Query can be run across multiple search engines
 - User needs to learn only the search interface of the meta search tool
 - Better results: retrieves top-ranking pages from individual search engines
- Disadvantages:
 - Unique features of individual search engines is lost
 - Not exhaustive: use only top results returned by search engines

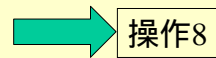



Search Strategies

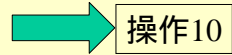
- 釐清問題
- 選擇合適的資料來源
- 以找到最佳證據“ the best evidence”為目標
- 用對MeSH，嘗試不同的關鍵字
- 先撒大網再慢慢限縮
- 嘗試不同的資料庫或搜尋器
- 閱讀文獻後，如有不同的關鍵字可再修正搜尋策略
- 儲存個人的搜尋策略

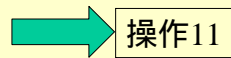
