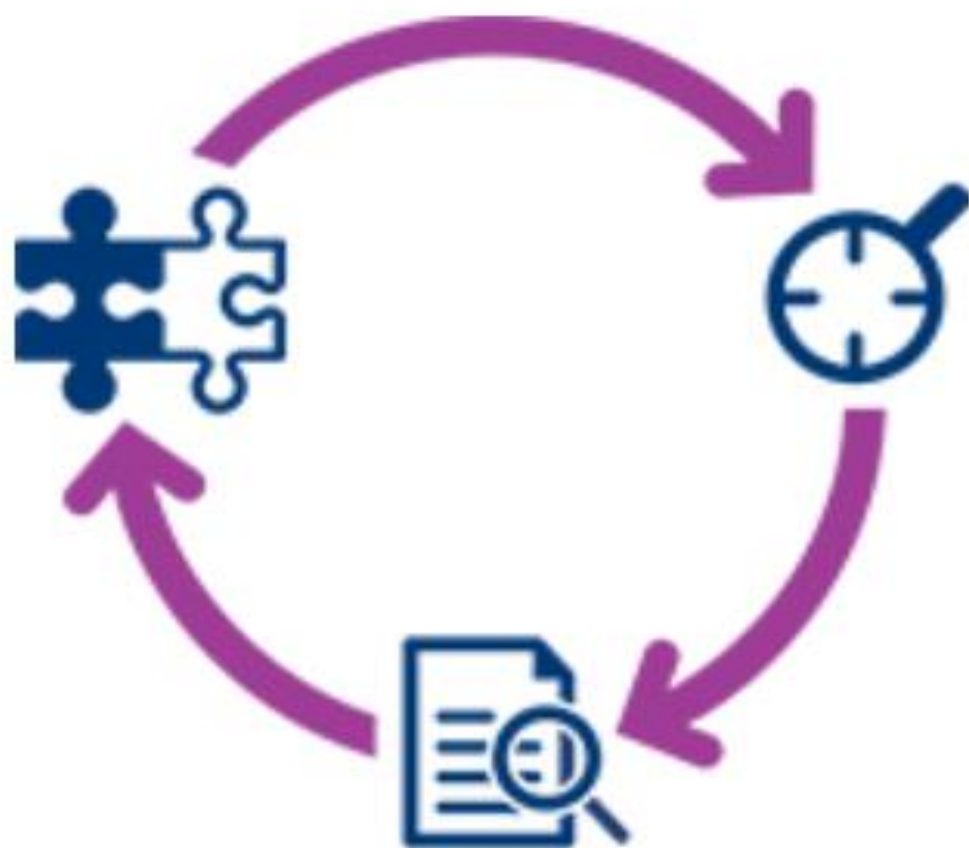

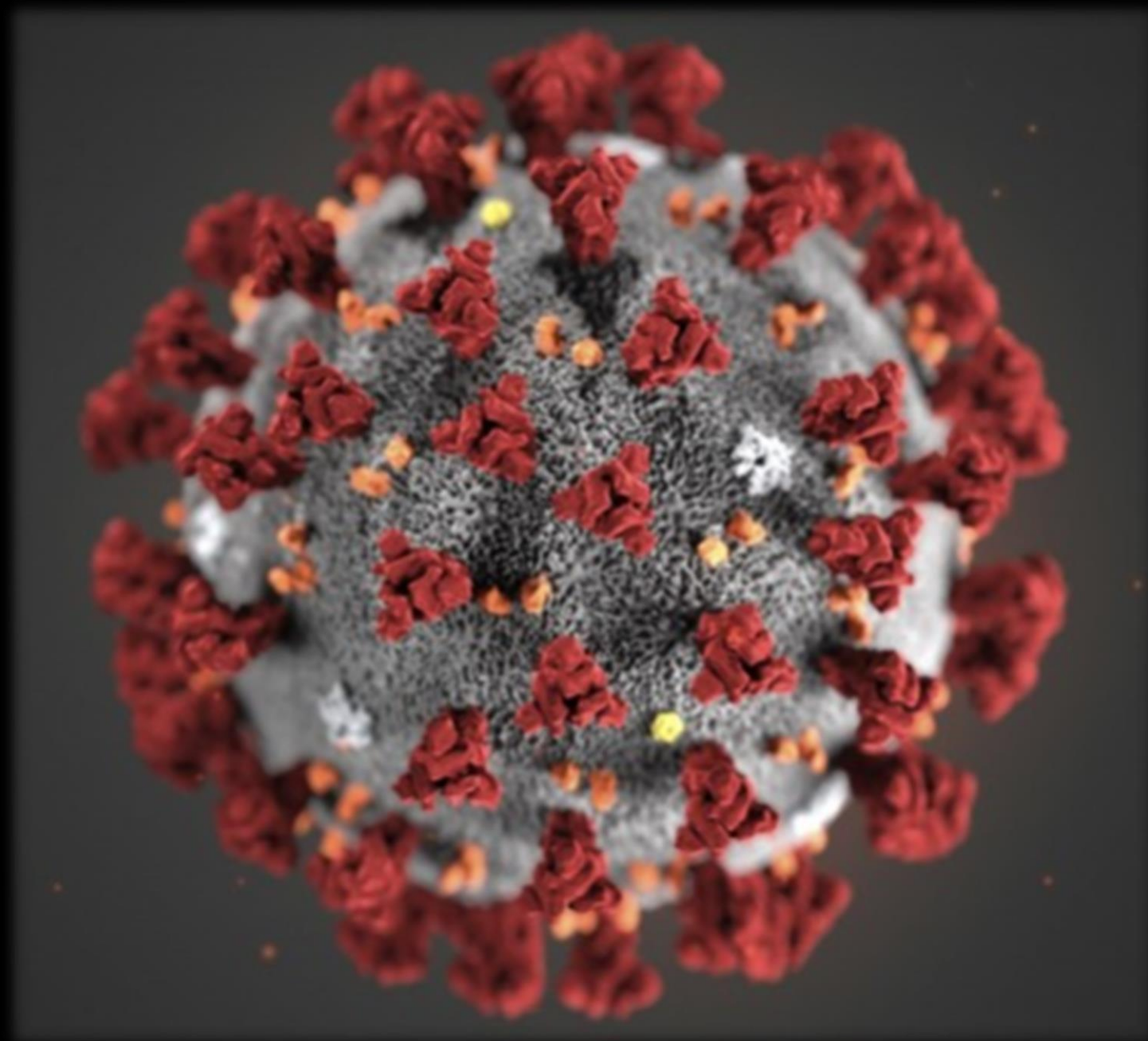
As a living systematic review, this review is continually updated, incorporating relevant new evidence as it becomes available
